Woodrow Wilson Elementary School- Parent Compact

School Responsibilities:

The Woodrow Wilson Elementary School will:

2. Hold parent- teacher conferences twice a year during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Those conferences will be held in December and April.
3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Students will receive report cards during each quarter.
4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows; Teachers may request meetings with parents during the school year. Conferences may be held before, during, and after the school day. Parents may observe their child during the school day after they have signed into the main office.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.

1. Monitoring attendance
2. Making sure that homework is completed
3. Monitoring amount of television our children watch
4. Volunteering in my child's classroom
5. Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education
6. Promoting positive use of my child's extra-curricular time
7. Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district wither received by child or by mail and responding as appropriate
8. Serving on school committees and chaperoning school events when possible
